COVID-19 specific terms and conditions & codes of conduct

1. Self-isolate and do not enter the premises if you or anyone in your household develops symptoms of COVID-19.
2. Do not enter the site if you or anyone in your household is waiting for COVID-19 test results.
3. Do not enter the site if you have previously been shielding on advice and receive a letter informing you to resume shielding.
4. If a player feels unwell (any symptoms) during the session, they must alert a member of staff and follow their instructions whilst preparing to leave.
5. Observe appropriate social distancing at all times.
6. Players must stay within their activity area and must not interfere with another session or group.
7. Players are to bring their own pre-filled water bottle with their name clearly labelled on it. If you need to use the water dispenser in the Sports Centre Building, only refill your own bottle – no face to tap drinking.
8. Please bring the bare minimum with you, players must put their belongings to the side of their pitch, NOT on another area. The coaching staff will inform the players where they are to put their things.
9. We have alternative entrances and exits available both in the sports hall & on the 3G pitch. Depending on where your football session is taking place, staff will direct players accordingly to reduce 'human traffic'.
10. Please use the designated drop off/pick up area, which is outside the front entrance to the Sports Centre. This area is no longer a car park and will be coned off with signage. A member of staff will be present with the players at the end of each session where you can collect them. Session times are staggered which will make the process easier.
11. Please use the outdoor Tennis Courts for parking.



12. We no longer accept cash! Online payments only.
13. Arrive and depart in your sports kit as changing facilities will not be available. If you require Accessible Facilities please contact us in advance and we will make the necessary arrangements for you.
14. Wash your hands or use the hand sanitiser provided upon arrival.
15. Enhanced cleaning will take place on site at regular intervals, you may see duty staff wearing PPE.
16. Equipment will be cleaned, bibs will be washed after each use and swapping/sharing bibs is not allowed.
17. Capacity numbers do apply. Note adults accompanying children or non-participants are included in the capacity. For this reason, we ask where possible for parents not to attend, however should you wish to watch the session then 1 x parent is allowed.
18. Indoor Football – Please note spectators will need to wear a mask in the sports hall and sit in the spectator area, chairs will be available and spaced out accordingly respecting social distancing rules. 1 x parent only allowed to spectate.
19. 3G – No parents or spectators are to enter the 3G pitch which is for players and staff only. Please watch from outside the 3G perimeter fence. 1 x parent only allowed to spectate.
20. Fully cooperate with the NHS Test and Trace requirements. Your personal data will be retained for 21 days in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation 2016 (GDPR).
21. Follow all COVID specific safety instructions given by duty staff or posted on notices on the premises.
